SPOTLIGHT: ZENOBIA C.

Zenobia Carson began working for the Lang Nelson Corporation in 2008 at the Twin Lake site in Brooklyn Center. Her job there consisted only of weekends and occasional week days in the office. It was a great fit because Zenobia was unable to work any longer at Odyssey Charter School or Children's World due to an ongoing illness.

A manager at Twin Lake found out about Zenobia's writing skills and asked if she would like to write the resident spotlights and that's where it all began! This led to the office assignment and she even worked in leasing for a short period of time. This gave her a more professional view of what Lang Nelson's mission statement is all about.

The work was intense at times, but Zenobia was still happy to have work and be able to continue raising her teen grandson.

In November of 2012, Zenobia was asked to do some fill-in work at another Lang Nelson property she had never heard of. That property was Creekside Gables in Brooklyn Park. Where Twin Lake North was multi-family, Creekside was an independent senior site. What began as temporary work turned into a permanent position in the office and as activities coordinator.

Since that day, Zenobia has been able to use her past skills as a person who is able to find resources to assist in securing funds through Hennepin County to bring about a garden from Backyard Farms that has helped to increase availability of fresh organic vegetables, has maintained an in house store that she established in 2013 AKA Zenobia's Community Store and has helped to partner with Good in The Hood and CEAP to bring two new food programs to Creekside Gables.



Zenobia has a genuine love for people and is always thinking up ways to help enrich the lives of her fellow seniors. As she approaches the age of seventy this month, she is thankful for many things. One of those things is her residency at Creekside, and her ability to oversee such activities as Bingo, Senior Talk with Zenobia and Bible Study every two weeks.

She attributes her joyful life with being able to express her joy through her writing (she is publishing her third

book) and has always stood on her faith in troubled times.

Working at Lang Nelson has helped her to hone and regain her skills as a life coach which she learned working in various human services positions in Minneapolis.

Zenobia is happy living and working at Creekside and hopes to do so for a long time!



MAINTENANCE TIPS AND CONCERNS, DID YOU KNOW:

With the change of seasons comes cooler weather, and now is a great time of year to make sure your apartment is as energy efficient as possible. The heat in your apartment is now

turned on! Here are some tips to help keep your home warm and cozy for the upcoming cold winter months:

- 1. Make sure your heat registers allow for the air circulation to flow freely, and all registers are free of restrictive furniture and window treatments.
- 2. Install your air conditioner cover tightly over your air conditioner.
- 3. After your heat is turned on, adjust your regulator valve to a level that is comfortable for your home, and maintain this temperature throughout the winter season.
- 4. Do not crack open windows or doors when the outside temperature drops below 32 degrees. This can cause pipes to freeze and break, causing extensive damage not only to your home, but those who live below you!
- 5. If you are experiencing any problems with heat regulation, please contact the office immediately so maintenance can be proactive with temperature issues.
