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Have you or anyone you know, ever asked, is it time?

Did you know that now is a great time to sell a home and receive top dollar? The LaNel Financial Group continuously receives market data from a variety of resources like lenders and professional associations, that outline the 'hot' single family real estate market buyers and sellers currently find themselves in.

The Minneapolis Association of Realtors (MAR) releases weekly status reports of home sale activity, one stat we found interesting was that in the home sale value range of \$300,000 and less, there was on average 2000 more showings on those homes than there was in the same January-June time period of 2020. The MAR graphs highlight this increase and support the rumors you are likely hearing. It's true, there are more buyers today looking for homes, then there were

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last year. What really stuck out to us, was that available homes on the market are significantly lower than in 2020, meaning there are less sellers on the market then last year, but with

more buyers than last year- which means we are currently in a sellers' market. Also, with the large number of buyers there has been more closed sales transactions then in 2020. Again, this is great news for sellers!

According to the Minneapolis Association of Realtors for the Twin Cities Region, the average length of time a home is on the market went from 47 days in 2020 to 31 days in (YTD) 2021. Also, the median sales price of those homes has risen from \$305,000 to \$337,000 in 2021. That is a 10.5% increase in sales price year over year. So, if you or someone you know has been thinking about selling their home, to begin their best years and be spoiled, time is now to get the home on the market. Statistics state, it will be gone within the month.
