"Accidents happen!" If you're like most, you'd be rich if you earned a nickel each time you heard this statement. Although, a few nickels may be all that it takes to truly save you from an expense, sometime exceeding hundreds or maybe even thousands of dollars.

In accordance with the Oxford Dictionary, an accident is "an unfortunate incident that happens unexpectedly and unintentionally, typically resulting in damage or injury." This suggests that an accident is often out of our control. It also suggests that it may happen when we least are prepared or able to manage it, both financially and emotionally. 
owner/landlord has insurance coverage that will protect them against any loss." This however is not the case.

- Broad: The most commonly purchased renter's policy, including damage by fire, smoke, water, vandalism, theft. Etc.
- Comprehensive: Not as common, this provides coverage for a range of events, and can carry higher premiums. It can also be predicated by location.

Tick Tick Talk about it 2023 is predicted to be the worst season for ticks in years. Tick bites can cause a variety of diseases, including Lyme



Disease, Anaplasmosis, Ehrlichiosis, Powassan Virus Disease, and Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever are just a few of the tick spread diseases that cause symptoms ranging from headaches, high fevers, joint and muscle pain, skin rashes and swelling, in some cases the viral infection of a tick bite can cause severe life threatening symptoms. So how can you enjoy the outdoors without the worry of tick bites? Here are some tips to avoid those pesky bugs hitching a ride on your skin.

- 1. Use an approved tick repellent when adventuring in a wooded or grassy area. Select an EPA approved product that contains permethrin for use on clothing and gear, do not apply directly to your skin. Repellents with a 30% DEET concentration can be used on adults and children (over the age of two months.)
- 2. Remove leaves and brush from around your home and play areas, make sure children's play equipment are in a sunny area of your yard preferably with a landscape barrier, also use a landscape barrier between your yard and any woods you may have.
- 3. Upon returning indoors from outdoor activity do a clothing/ gear check and a full body tick check (for yourself and your pets) especially in hair where ticks may be more difficult to see.

If you find a tick that has attached itself, remove by using a tweezer or your fingers grasping the tick close to the head of the tick and pull outward then wash the area with soap and water. Avoid using ineffective methods such as nail polish remover or Vaseline; it is important to remove the tick as quickly as possible to avoid any viral transmission.

There are also several tick preventive measures for your pets. Talk to your vet about preventive medicines and collars that repel ticks for your furry family members.

Taking precautions and preventive measures will allow you to enjoy the outdoors all summer long!
